


# celebrate SACRAMENTS

### Confirmation

Confirmation Registration for youth in grades 6 and up will be in March 2019.

If you are an adult who needs to be Confirmed, contact Linda.

The Rite of Christian Initiation for Adults (and Youth/Children), also known as RCIA (RCIY/RCIC), begins in September and continues through to Pentecost. This journey allows people to come to know God and learn about the faith in an immersive way, as well as building strong foundations in the community. Those who go through the process will receive the Sacraments of Initiation (Baptism, Eucharist, and Confirmation) at the Easter Vigil. Adults who have been Baptized but have not received their Eucharist or Confirmation will also be part of this process.
