* You need not abide by a specific pattern. Feel free to use the pattern you are comfortable with.

* You may make as many as you want 5? 10? 15?

* If you are burnt out from already making masks, you might consider donating fabric. If so, please contact Yvette or Connie to arrange pickup. Yes, Yvette will go pick it up.

* If you have friends who are interested in donating to this cause... that would be great!

* There are 200 students and staff at AIM School... it would be wonderful if we could donate that many.

* Please let Yvette or Connie know how many you would like to make and donate, and what size (child or adult).

Annet has intentions of returning to Uganda and would bring them with her. However, should borders not be open to international travel, she would mail them.

Please help us protect the health of the students and staff at AIM School.
