





What has caused the flooding?



- A decrease in Sunday loose collections



- The return of the maintenance contract to pre pandemic contractual amount

- An increase in Utilities due to rising prices, weather and the addition of the carbon tax.

- An increase in the cost of custodian supplies





We need to stop the flooding and focus on meeting all of our monthly operational commitments.

What can we do?

324 families add \$20.00 to their monthly donation

648 families add \$10.00 to their monthly donation

1296 families add \$5.00 to their monthly donation

These additional donations need to be ongoing so that each month we receive enough funds to cover all of our expenses.





The Roofing Project Repayment will be done in October however we will continue to need donations to cover the payments to the Archdiocese.


















We are continuing our Parish Campaign to raise funds to take care of the Church Building of St. Charles and to build our Church Community into the future.
