St. Charles KC Council operates a beer booth at Commonwealth Stadium as its main fundraiser to support the various charity programs. The council has been working a beer booth since 1990 at stadium for all kinds of events including football games, concerts, and other events.

The St. Charles KC Beer Booth Volunteer appreciation and celebration event was held at Jubilations Dinner Theatre at West Edmonton Mall on Thursday November 10. Forty-seven volunteers and spouses and friends attended the Heartbreak Hotel event at Jubilations <u>Heartbreak Hotel | Jubilations Dinner Theatre</u>.

It was a very successful year of working fourteen events at Commonwealth Stadium this year and we may have one more event on December 10 for the World Cup Snowboard competition. We had 53 different volunteers working the various beer booth events this year.

Beer Booth 6 generated about \$307,500 in revenue for Western Foods who manage the concessions at Commonwealth Stadium for the City of Edmonton and the Elks. The council will receive about \$17K income plus \$12K tips. Most of the funds are used to support St. Charles Parish, CWL, St. Vincent De Paul, parish schools, and other charitable groups.
