February Pancake Breakfast




Pancake Breakfast

Twenty-five years have passed since the death of Mother Teresa of Calcutta, sparking a renewed interest in this spiritual giant of the 20th century. Filmed on five continents and featuring unprecedented access to both institutional archives and the apostolates of the Missionaries of Charity, this film reveals not just who Mother Teresa was, but how her singular vision to serve Christ in the poor continues to be realized through the Missionaries of Charity today. This is far more than a documentary film. It is at once a soaring tribute to a spiritual icon, a powerful witness of authentic Christian charity, and a guidepost for all who seek hope in our turbulent times.

Next KC Family Movie Night is on Saturday March 18 featuring the movie The Bad Guys starting at 6:30 PM.


Family Day Celebration

Faith in Action



Free Throw Championship

After a three-year hiatus due to COVID, St. Charles Council is again running the KC Free Throw Championship program. The Council 8325 and District 12 competitions will be held on Sunday March 5 at St. Cecilia Junior High School. There will be youth from eight different schools participating including Bishop Savaryn, Katherine Therrien, St. Charles, St. Lucy, St. Timothy, Bishop Greschuk, St. John Bosco and Father Leo Green.

Since 1972, councils have sponsored the Knights of Columbus Free Throw Championship for boys and girls from the ages of 9 to 14 to provide an athletic outlet and encourage the values of sportsmanship and healthy competition. Kids compete within their own gender and age and progress from council to district, regional and provincial competitions.
