


Laughter is Good for the Soul

CWL Virtual Book Club Fun Fact

Reading for just 6 minutes each day can help reduce stress by up to 68%, study finds.

A 2009 study at the University of Sussex found that reading can reduce stress by up two thirds – making it a much more

efficient relaxation method than listening to music, drinking a hot cup of tea, or even taking a walk.

Participants who engaged in just six minutes of reading for pleasure were found to have a significantly slower heart rate and reduced muscle tension.


