#### **Council Events in June**

- The KC Men's Choir sang at the 9:00 Mass on Sunday June 4 Most Holy Trinity. Brother Gerald Murnane led the choir and was joined by members of St. Charles KC Council. The KC Men's Choir is scheduled to sing at the 9:00 Mass on the first Sunday of each month. The Men's Choir sing again on Sunday July 2 – 13<sup>th</sup> Sunday in Ordinary Time.
- The Pancake Breakfast on Sunday, June 11, went very well. There was a lot of help from the 25+ volunteers working both shifts. We hosted approximately 150 people after the 9:00 AM Mass and 120 people after the 11:00 AM Mass. The next Pancake Breakfast is on Sunday September 10.
- The council operated three different beer booths at Commonwealth Stadium in June. On Saturday June 3, over 50,000 fans packed the stadium for the Luke Combs concert. Twenty-five beer booth volunteers worked at the concert event for over five hours serving many of those fans. The revenue for the beer booth was almost \$84,000. On Sunday June 11, the Saskatchewan Roughriders came to town to play the Edmonton Elks. Saskatchewan won the football game 17 to 13 in front of over 32,000 fans. Nineteen beer booth volunteers worked that day and sold over \$15,000 in beer, coolers, wine, water and popcorn. On Sunday June 11, twelve beer booth volunteers worked at the beer booth. About 12,000 fans came out to cheer for the Elks but they lost again to the Toronto Argonauts 43 to 31. The beer booth revenue was \$4,581. Western Foods manages all the food and alcohol booths at Commonwealth Stadium. Our next beer booth is on Thursday July 13 when the Hamilton Tiger Cats come to play the Edmonton Elks.
- Pat Burant presented two \$500 council scholarships to very deserving winners Kendra Merkowsky and Mateo Stagliano. The council received fifteen applications for the 2023 scholarship award.


