WHAT: Quilt Tops to be donated to WINGS of Providence

WHEN: Fall 2023 - Spring 2024

WINGS (Women in Need Growing Stronger) of Providence creates a safe and welcoming home for women and children who are escaping domestic abuse. The fully furnished apartments provide needed shelter for survivors. They are looking for quilts (twin size) to put on the beds.

Quilt top specifications:

- Fabric
 - o 100% cotton (preferably) or a blend of cotton and polyester
- Dimensions
 - o Twin quilt size varies from 56" to 64" by 84" to 100"
- Pattern
 - o Be creative! It's up to you. It can be as simple as sewing strips together.
- Finishing the quilt
 - o In order to finish the quilts we would need donations of the following:
 - The batting
 - The backing
 - The quilting (one of our members has volunteered to quilt the tops)
 - O You may also choose to finish it yourself!!

Participation:

Whether you sew or not, there are several ways to participate.

- Making a top
- Donating fabric (100% cotton)
- Donating batting (can be bought at Michaels, don't forget the 30% coupon)
- Donating backing fabric




"Why? Who's going to stop me?" Joel asked. Angie pointed to the back of the church and said, "See those two men standing by the door? They're hushers."
