#### **Council Events in November**

#### **Marriages**

The statistics quoted here come from an article produced by the Sherwood Baptist Church of Albany, Georgia. This is a shocker: A vast number of re-marriages end in divorce. Approximately 76 percent of second marriages, 87 percent of third marriages, and 93 percent of fourth marriages are doomed! It becomes obvious that remarriage is not a solution. It merely establishes a pattern of failure. Then what is the solution? Monogamy. Don't divorce.

But many of us are in relationships that are volatile, sometimes lethal. What can we do? The first thing is reconcile. Apologize. Defuse the situation. Try to re-establish a relationship. Court your partner again. Your best chance of a happy marriage is with your original partner.

The institution of marriage is under attack by society. We are force-fed the idea that we don't have to stay married, and even while married we can cheat with impunity. But we must recognize that we are here on earth for a very short time (at most a hundred years) and this is a "proving ground" for our eternity. When we die, we will face Jesus and perhaps have to explain to Him why we didn't do our best to bring others to heaven - in particular our wife (or husband). Try to put this time on earth in a proper perspective. What we experience here on earth is very temporary. What we will experience after we die is very permanent.
